1	Application Form completely filled and signed with two (2) Signatures (for minors the application form should be
	signed by <u>BOTH</u> parents).
2	Two (2) recent photographs 35x40 mm with white back ground (not photoshoped) not older than 6 months
3	Passport with 90 days validity from the date of return from the Schengen area and with at least 2 non-used visa pages.
4	Invitation from an Italian citizen or a foreigner resident in Italy according to the format provided.

	Copy of Valid passport of Italian citizen OR Copy of Valid Identity card of Italian Citizen
	Foreigner resident in Italy requires to submit Copy of resident permit.
5	Copies of Passport (first page), previous Schengen (with entry and exit stamps), UK and US visa.
6	All MINORS are required to provide the consent letter attested by the Ministry of Justice & Ministry of Foreign affairs
7	Original Documents proving financial means of support during your stay in Italy: Bank Statement for last three months
	showing the transactions signed and stamped by bank in English.
	Optional: Bank guarantee from Italy & Title Deed
8	Birth Certificate (Translated by legal translator in English or Italian)
9	Copy of Medical Travel Insurance with coverage of Minimum 30,000 € covering the entire trip.
10	Copy of Airline ticket or reservations
11	Translated documents proving the family or relative relation with the person residing in Italy. For unmarried couples,
	self-declaration from the person living in Italy pursuant to DPR 445/2000, about stable nature of the emotional
	relationship and the intention to host the visa applicant at his/her home.
Declaration:	
I understand that an application without a complete set of documents (as per the checklist above) may result in refusal	
of my visa application.	
The submission of a complete file does not guarantee the issuance of a visa.	
The documents should be submitted personally by the applicant himself at the appointment date.	
The ITALIAN EMBASSY in Iran reserves the right to request additional documents if deemed necessary for a better	
evaluation of visa application.
